





SYMPTOM	<i>Not being able to force with the affected area or not being able to stand (hip).</i>	<i>Presence of blood coming out uninterrupted.</i>	<i>Internal pain.</i>	<i>Loss of consciousness</i>	<i>Not being able to speak well, without consistency, or not being able to move the left or right half of the body.</i>
1st STEP:	Move as little as possible.	Make a tourniquet, and open it every 2 min and close again.	Move as little as possible.	Put the affected person in a vehicle and turn on the emergency lights.	Put the affected person in a vehicle and turn on the emergency lights.
2nd STEP:	Drive to Hospital of Elche "Urgencias". Standby time: 2-3 hours.	Drive to the Ambulatory Center of Santa Pola or Hospital. Standby time: Immediate.	Drive to Hospital of Elche "Urgencias".
